Shropshire Council has no budget to modify the existing waiting/stopping signage. The yellow lines are within the remit of the parking enforcement officer and it was agreed to ask them to visit the area more frequently. It was agreed to put this on the agenda for the Annual Parish Meeting. It was noted that it may be possible to approach local businesses such as the Co-Op, Boots Trust and the NISA garage for assistance with funding.
