#### 38/1920 **REPORTS**

- a) Shropshire Council Oxon Relief Road going to be incorporated into NW Relief Road. Shopping centre income down but the Leader of SC feels it is still good long-term investment. Consultations in progress. Road repairs – new machine tested at Whitchurch and now to be going around the county – repair meant to be faster and more permanent. Climate emergency – SC declared one, sub-committee meeting. Brexit – SC have now appointed Claire Porter as Brexit Officer and meeting weekly. SC has formed a housing company as a stand-alone company. Expecting first homes to be ready early 2020, focusing on smaller homes.
- b) Youth Club consultation now launched open for 8 weeks, re SC funding. Outreach workers will be town based with little focus on rural area. It was <u>RESOLVED</u> that the clerk be delegated to respond to the consultation and circulate it via email.

It was further <u>RESOLVED</u> to instruct G Taylor to carry out minor repairs to the children's play area and mend the basketball hoop. It was also <u>RESOLVED</u> to instruct Landright Services to treat invasive weeds.
  - (iii) Tree survey review & report of overhanging willows it was <u>**RESOLVED**</u> to approve quote from Shropshire Council of  $\pounds 400 + VAT$  and to delegate the Finance Committee powers to agree works to the trees
- d) Housing Needs Study meeting scheduled for 26<sup>th</sup> Sep.
- e) Greenbanks Cllr. Jones had a call from the owner who had assured him that it will be sorted and that he has an agent in the village acting on his behalf. Karen Collier, Regulatory Services Officer, wants to know if PC still wants action; the property has been on SC's radar since 2011. Section 215 is a useful tool but may not return the property to use. Cllr. Evans to ask for enforcement, starting with Section 215. It was **RESOLVED** to ask for action to be taken.
